We are looking to update our access control system. Our goal is to improve our system within the constraints of budget and grant approval.



 - Roscommon High School
- Current system
 - Controller system software and boards
 - System Galaxy Version 10.4.9.1
 - 5 controllers Board Model 600
 - Roscommon Elementary -2 Controllers
 - Roscommon MS 2 Controllers
 - Roscommon HS 1 Controllers
 - 20 Doors/Readers
 - Roscommon Elementary 7
 - Roscommon MS 9
 - Roscommon HS 4
 - Middle School has 3 AlPhone desktop camera/buzzer locations
 - High School has one AIPhone buzzer/call button that is not connected to system and one door with electronic latch that is not connected to the system and does not have a reader.
- Upgrades and/or new system preferences and goals
 - Upgraded software and controller boards if upgrading current system OR a new controller system to work with existing electronic latches and readers, etc.


- Integrated New/upgraded entry camera/buzzer/intercom at one elementary school entrances/offices
 - one camera/buzzer/intercom and two desk receivers
- Integrated New/upgraded entry camera/buzzer/intercom at one high school school entrances/offices
 - one camera/buzzer/intercom and two desk receivers
 - 1 high school entrance/office
 - one camera/ buzzer and one or two desk receivers



- Integrated New/upgraded entry camera/buzzer/intercom at two middle school entrances/offices
 - Board office entrance camera/buzzer/intercom and two desk receivers
 - Middle office entrance camera/buzzer/intercom and two desk receivers
- Middle school needs to add electronic latches and fob readers to three entrance doors in close proximity at our CTE entrance that is part of a new build
 - Including One buzzer/camera
 - two desk receivers
 - three door readers/latches
- Bid should include:
 - installation
 - options and/or itemization to allow us to adjust the project size and scope to meet budgetary constraints
 - educational pricing and indicated as such on the bid if available
 - system installation, setup, testing, training
 - o min. 1 year of support
- Budgetary Constraints
 - We have approx \$17,000 to \$20,000 per building of grant money for this project
 - We can possibly spend additional funds, please include proposal with itemized costs so we can best allocate our available budget
- Installation before July 1, 2023 to comply with grant deadline
- Project Approval Subject to:
 - School Board Approval
 - Grant Provider Approval
- Installers must be able to be cleared to work in schools.

All bids shall be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing familial relationships that exist between the owner or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Board or the Superintendent of the school district. All bids shall also be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing whether the bidder is an Iran Linked Business in compliance with PA 517 of 2012. These statements are included in this document.
- 3. Bids will be opened and reviewed at the Superintendent's Office at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 6, 2023.
- 4. Bid may be awarded by the Board of Education at the regular board meeting on Monday, April 17, 2023 at 6 p.m.
- 5. Roscommon Area Public Schools reserves the right to waive any irregularities in bidding, reject any or all bids, accept any bid when, in the opinion of Roscommon Area Public Schools, such action will serve the best interest of the Roscommon Area Public Schools consistent with competitive bidding requirements. All bids must be held firm for sixty days. Also, the Board reserves the right to waive any irregularities.
- 6. All quotations must fully comply with State regulations. Any variations in specs other than those requested must be stated in writing.
- 7. It will not be necessary for any of your representatives to meet with the Board of Education.
